



Cossington Neighbourhood Plan Referendum Information Statement

This statement has been prepared to meet Regulation 4(3) (a) of the Neighbourhood Planning (Referendum) Regulations 2012 (as amended). A Referendum relating to the adoption of the Cossington Parish Neighbourhood Development Plan will be held on 30th November 2023.

The question which will be asked in the Referendum is: **Do you want Charnwood Borough Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Cossington Parish to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?**

The Referendum area is identified on the map included on the next page. It is the same area that has been designated as the Cossington Parish neighbourhood area.

The referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures similar to those used at local government elections. A person is entitled to vote in the Referendum if they are:

- Entitled to vote in a local government election in the Referendum area; and
- Have a qualifying address for the election in the Referendum area. A person's qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the register of electors, the address in respect of which he or she is entitled to be registered.

The Referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the Referendum is £2,362 plus 5.9p for each person entitled to vote in the Referendum, which for this referendum totals 388 electors.

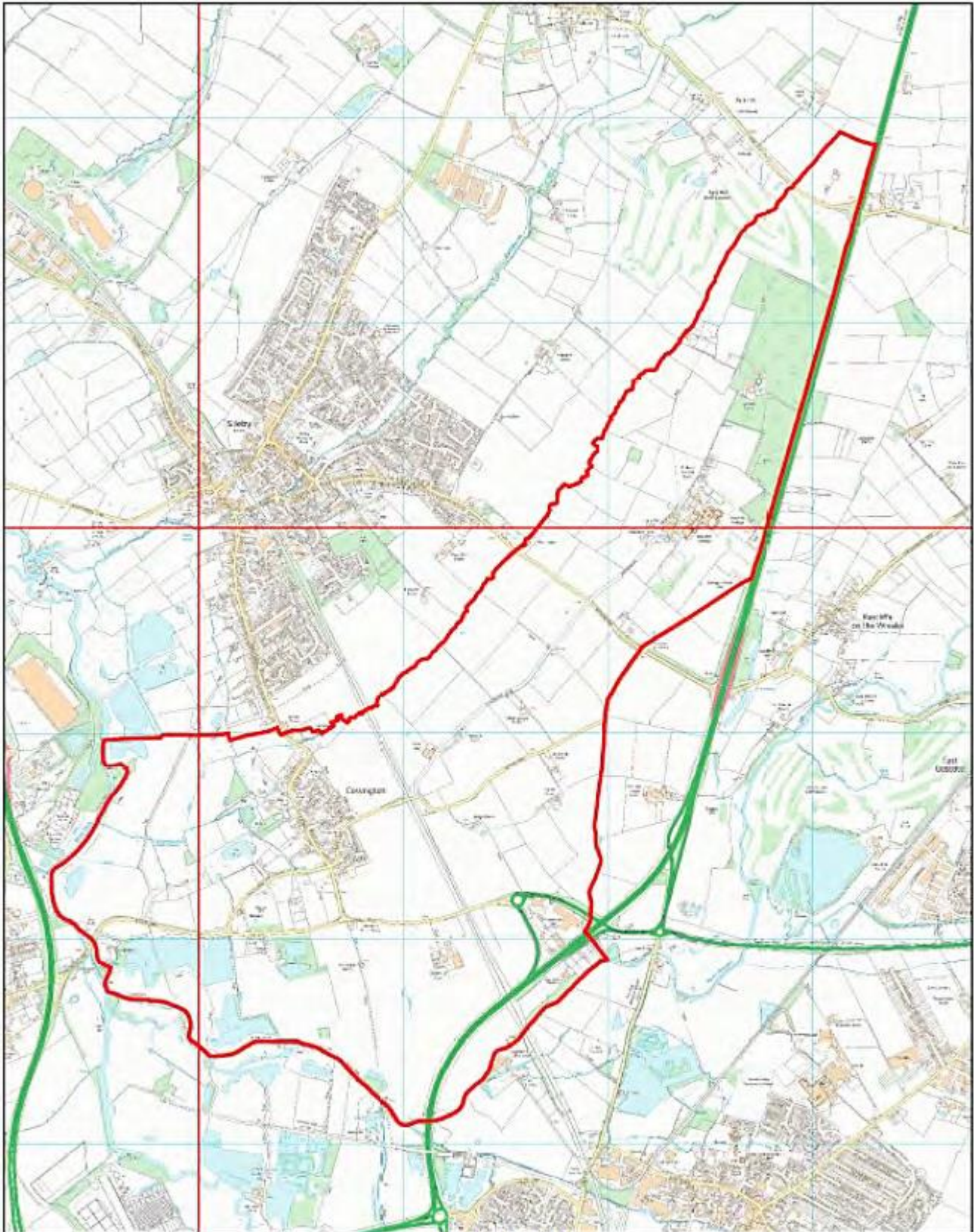
- Cossington Parish Neighbourhood Plan 2021-2037 Referendum Version
