58716	<p><u>Public Questions</u></p> <p>1. Leicestershire County Councillor Update Nothing to report.</p> <p>2. Charnwood Borough Councillor Update Cllr Poland told the Councillors about the Public Spaces Protection Order consultation Charnwood Borough Council are running.</p> <p>Public Spaces Protection Orders (PSPO's) replace existing Dog Control Orders under the new Anti-Social Behaviour Crime and Policing Act 2014. The Council would like to seek views on the proposed Notice of Intention to make an order.</p> <p>Notice is given that the council proposes for the purposes of reducing antisocial behaviour in relation to dog control to make a Public Spaces Protection Order under Section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 and of all other enabling powers. All comments or objections must be made before December 6, 2016.</p> <p>Cllr Poland to arrange for a replacement dog bin at the top of Bennett's Lane as it has been reported broken.</p> <p>The Councillors questioned if the Wimpy signs that have appeared on lamp posts around the village should legally be allowed to be put there. Cllr Poland informed the Councillors that Wimpy will have applied for temporary permission to put them up.</p>	J.P.

Back Lane Car Park The Clerk reported that we should have received all of the quotes for dismantling the garages by the December Parish Council meeting. 2. Christmas Lights The Clerk informed the Councillors that the new set of lights have arrived. MPES Ltd will install the lights before 1st December and they will be taken down on the 12th night. 3. War Memorial Surround Repairs The Clerk reported that all the repair work has been carried out on the War Memorial surround and that the insurance company are paying James Toon & Son directly for the work. 4. Crab Tree Lane Leicestershire County Council have confirmed that the part of Polly Peggs Lane between Homestead Close and Bennetts Lane/Back Lane has no registered owner. Also, it is not recorded as a public right of way on the Definitive Map. However, it has a link to it from Fisher Close as well as Homestead Close, and as it has presumably been used by the public for over 20 years, it can probably be assumed to have acquired public rights. Cossington Parish Council has powers to maintain a public footpath within the parish under the Highways Act 1980 ss 43 and 50. The footpath can be either publicly maintainable or privately maintainable. The continuation of the path between Homesteads Lane and Main Street is recorded as public footpath I62 on the Definitive Map. Mr Astill is the registered owner for this section. 5. Report of Meetings Attended Mrs Weston-Webb reported that Platt's Charity are hoping to have the "Green Gym" installed by the end of November. Mrs Weston-Webb also reported that not many representatives attended the Charnwood Road Safety meeting. Mr Shuttlewood attended the Neighbourhood Watch meeting – requested to report the broken "Kissing Gate".
