Leicestershire County Councillor Update Cllr Houseman informed the Councillors that the provisional Care and Support Plan for Adult Social Care budget will go to Leicestershire County Council in February 2017 and will be set for the next 4 years.</p> <p>2. Back Lane Car Park (Closed from 30th January – 2nd February) Croft Environment will be dismantling the garages on Back Lane carpark from 30th January – 2nd February. The Clerk to put signage up on each garage and around the carpark informing residents that the car park will be closed and the garages demolished.</p> <p>2. Pot Holes on War Memorial Driveway Before the Council arrange to have the pot holes filled in the Councillors agreed for the Clerk to write to the Church Project Group to ask if they can email the Parish Council an update with regards to the installation of the utility pipes in the Memorial Carpark.</p> <p>3. Network Rail – Closure of Syston Bridge The Clerk read out the reply from Ms Payne at Leicestershire County Council to the Councillors. The letter informed the Councillors that Leicestershire County Council have worked closely with Network Rail, and their contractor's J Murphy & Sons to agree the initial works programme and appropriate diversion route. 	<p>the signed diversion route, and unfortunately traffic cannot be prohibited from choosing to use local routes, even when an approved, alternative signed diversion is in place. Signing in advance of the closure points has been erected to give drivers adequate warning of the restrictions in order to encourage the use of the approved diversion.</p> <p>To mitigate any damage that may occur to the road surfaces on the Lanes Leicestershire County Council has arranged for their Condition Technician for the village to carry out additional scheduled inspections to address any immediate deterioration of the road surface. Ms Payne also informed that she has spoken to J Murphy & Sons who have willingly agreed to carry out verge repairs at the end of the contract period on both Bennetts Lane and Back Lane.</p> <p>Ms Payne has also informed the Council that some delays have been experienced on site due to the installation of drainage on the northern embankment, due to poor weather and they are looking to extend the road closure period for an additional 3 weeks, with a revised end date of 7th April. Weekend working is currently being utilised to mitigate the delay.</p> <p>The Councillors agreed for the Clerk to reply to Ms Payne to ask if LCC can contact J Murphy & Sons to ask if their heavy vehicles can use the official diversions and not the Humbles, Back Lane and Bennetts, as they are seen to be doing.</p> <p>4.
