Leicestershire County Councillor Update Cllr Poland reported that at the last County Council meeting the Leader reminded Members that the Medium Term Financial Strategy calls for £66m of savings to be made, £23m of which have yet to be identified. This is inevitably going to lead to some very difficult decisions as to what services County Council provide.</p> <p>The Department of Transport has reported that no authority in England has better road conditions across all three road classifications than Leicestershire. County Council are very pleased and intends to maintain this status for as long as possible.</p> <p>Cllr Poland informed the Councillors that Dave Houseman, former County Councillor has been made an honorary Alderman of Leicestershire for his outstanding service to the people of Leicestershire through his duties as a Councillor. The Councillors asked the Clerk to write and congratulate Dave on behalf of Cossington Parish Council.</p> <p>2. Charnwood Borough Councillor Update Mrs Weston-Webb asked Cllr Poland if he could enquire as to why there are lorries parked at Chestnut Farm as the work for Network Rail is now complete.</p> <p>3.
