Leicestershire County Councillor Update Lightbulb Housing Support Service is a pioneering programme which aims to make it easier to find and receive practical housing support to live at home will be rolled out across Leicestershire from 2nd October. Lightbulb will provide one contact point for a range of services including access to help and advice with affordable warmth, technology to keep residents safe around the home, home adaptations and Occupational Therapy support plus other help and advice to live well and safely at home.</p> <p>2. Charnwood Borough Councillor Update The Leader of Charnwood Borough Council has announced he is to resign as Leader of the Full Council meeting in November. The Conservative Group is in the process of selecting our successor as Group Leader.</p> <p>5 Year Land Supply - Local planning authorities must be able to show that enough houses can be built within five years to meet the need for homes. If they can't then housing supply policies in local plans cannot be considered up to date and they become less influential when making decisions on planning applications, Whilst there is a significant amount of land with permission for housing in Charnwood the amount that is expected to be delivered within the next five years is not sufficient to meet the amount required. At the moment, the figure is 4.6 years.</p> <p>3. Representative from Neighbourhood Watch Cllr Poland agreed to speak to Graham Crompton of the Charnwood Road Safety Committee about the possibilities of running a speed watch and the different options which could be installed to slow the traffic down on Main Street through the village.</p>	J.P.
