73418	<p><b><u>Public Questions</u></b></p> <p>1. Leicestershire County Councillor Update Nothing to report.</p> <p>2. Charnwood Borough Councillor Update Cllr Poland informed the Councillors that the Government published its revised National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF). As Charnwood Borough expected this has changed the way the five year supply is calculated and the Council is now able to demonstrate it has 5.93 years of housing supply. The figure should be viewed with some caution at this stage, as the government has not published its detailed guidance on the interpretation to be given to the policy and this is therefore officers' initial interpretation of the approach to be taken to the calculation.</p>

Speeding &amp; Parked Vehicles Mr Shuttlewood informed the Councillors that the NHW are not wanting to be involved in the Community Speed Watch campaign. The Councillors were disappointed to hear this as this is the third piece of evidence to progress matters. The Clerk to write to NHW to ask if they can put it in writing that they do not want to take part – this then can be forwarded onto Graham Compton at Leicestershire Police and the item can be removed from the Parish Councils Agenda.</p> <p>2. 	<p>3. Flower Planter The Clerk informed the Councillors that the signed copy of the License has been returned from Charnwood Borough Council. Mr Sanderson agreed to get a quote for the planter.</p> <p>4. Listed Barn – Main Street Cllr Poland informed the Councillors that Charnwood Borough Council still haven't published a decision for the barn but the Planning Officer met with the applicant and agent recently and advised them that, notwithstanding the existing building on the site, permission will be refused for a dwelling. This should be issued in the next 10 working days.</p> <p>5. Vehicles Parked Behind the Old Rectory (Heritage Room) Charnwood Borough Council are looking into the cars parked behind the Old Rectory.</p> <p>6. Platt's Charity Parish Council Representative Trustee The Clerk is waiting to hear from Chris Antliff to confirm he would like to take the position of Representative Trustee for Platt's Charity. Once the Clerk has heard she will inform the Chairman of the charity.</p> <p>7. Cossington Flood Alleviation The Clerk has received an email from Daniel Watson, Environment &amp; Transport Department at Leicestershire County Council who has previously investigated this area twice, both close together in 2013, one of which was to support a response to an enquiry from Cossington Parish Council. Mr Watson has reviewed his responses to the enquiries in 2013 in conjunction with today's information and would not disagree with the conclusions reached at that time. However, he did state that highway records are not definitive, so should the Council have any further information that would warrant a review of these conclusions he would look into it further. The Councillors asked the Clerk to contact Malcolm Kitching member of the All Saint's Church, Cossington to ask if the Church own the land.</p> <p>8. Christmas Lights Mr Shuttlewood to look at the boxes of lights we have in storage and let the Clerk know how many lights there are. The Clerk to contact MPES Ltd to ask if they can install the Christmas lights at the War Memorial for 1<sup>st</sup> December and to take down on the 12<sup>th</sup> night.</p> <p>9.
