The 12-week exercise runs until 8th September. A questionnaire is also being sent to households in a special edition of the Leicestershire Matters newsletter.</p> <p>2. Part of the completion of works is to level off the car park with the excess stone by filling in the pot holes and to solid roll tarmac plainings along the driveway contouring it away from the cottages. Also, NMCA will check with the Parish Council to agree to the bollards, which are to go outside of the cottages. A manhole is being left with a stub for the church to connect to the sewage.
