82519	<p><u>Public Questions</u></p> <p>1. Leicestershire County Councillor Update Leicestershire County Council's energy consumption has been cut by 63%. Last year, the Council finished upgrading 68,000 street lights to LEDs as part of a planned £25 million investment programme. The scheme which is set to save Leicestershire tax payers £2 million a year has already seen a reduction in the carbon produced, down from 14,752 tonnes in 2013/14 to 3,071 tonnes per year - a 78.9% reduction. This and future reductions in carbon emissions will contribute to a commitment to achieve carbon neutrality as a Council by 2030 following the declaration of a climate emergency on 15 May 2019.</p> <p>2. Charnwood Borough Councillor Update Charnwood Borough Council has welcomed news that Loughborough is in line for up to £25 million of funding to regenerate the town. The announcement on the 6th September by Local Government Secretary Rt Hon Robert Jenrick is a massive opportunity for Loughborough. The Government has revealed that 100 places around the country will invited to develop proposals for a new generation of multi-million-pound Town Deals. It says communities, businesses and local leaders will join forces to draw up ambitious plans to transform their town's economic growth prospects with a focus on improved transport, broadband connectivity, skills and culture. This is fantastic news for Loughborough and the whole of Charnwood as it presents a huge opportunity to shape the future of Loughborough for many years to come.</p>
